

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
Program Benefits

The NEW Scholar Pledge

- Graduate with at least a Core 40 high school diploma and a cumulative 2.5 Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Complete the Scholar Success Program to plan, prepare and pay for college success
- Apply for college admissions and financial aid on time as high school senior
- **Refrain from** using alcohol and illegal drugs or committing a crime or delinquent act
