## Scholarship Program

### Introduction

The Boone County Solid Waste Management District (õDistrictö) is responsible for implementing programs to educate and promote proper integrated solid waste management within Boone County. Elements of the various programs include:

- Waste Reduction
- Recycling
- Composting
- Resource Recovery
- Prevention of Illegal Dumping & Burning
- Proper Disposal of Household Hazardous Waste, Expired or Unwanted Medications and Non-Recyclable Solid Waste

To supplement the Districtos efforts toward continued progress in meeting the objectives of the Districtos programs, the District is pleased to offer a \$500 scholarship to each school with Boone County residents. The scholarship program is intended to provide support and reward a student that has been involved in his or her community while being environmentally conscience along the way.

#### **Scholarship Guidelines & Eligibility**

Scholarship applicants must meet the following requirements to be eligible for consideration:

- Boone County Resident
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Implemented and/or Facilitated an Environmental Program within the Community that falls within the Districtor goals (i.e. Recycling Programs, Educational Programs for Composting, Utilizing Reclaimed Materials for Resale or Project Work, etc.)

OR

Plan to Major in Environmental Studies in an Accredited 2 or 4 Year Program in the Fall of 2016

## **Grant Review Process**

Each scholarship application will be reviewed by the Districtos Citizenso Advisory Committee (ocaci) and the District staff. The CAC, with input from the staff, will forward recommendations to the Districtos Board Members. The Board will review the applications and the recommendations provided, and make a final decision regarding scholarship awards.
