BOONE COUNTY 4-H BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP



- 1. This scholarship is open to any high school senior at the time of application who has been an active member of Boone County 4-H for the last 5 years of 4-H eligibility and is presently enrolled in Boone County 4-H.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded to the recipient regardless of the recipient's school choice. However, awards will be honored only if the recipient is enrolled in the selected school beginning with the semester immediately following graduation.
- 3. Money will be given for two semesters or terms; one-half August 1; one-half December 1 provided that at least a C average or deemed equivalent is maintained the first semester. The money will be mailed directly to the recipient.
- 4. If for any reason the recipient does not remain in school during the first semester the scholarship will be forfeited and he or she must immediately notify the 4-H Youth Educator, Boone County Extension Office.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained from the Boone County Extension Office or local schools. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1st.
- 6. The 4-H Scholarship(s) will be awarded to the applicant(s) who, in the judgment of the Selection Committee, appear most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - a. The applicant shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school and community involvement will be considered.
 - b. The applicant's academic record and career goals will be considered.
 - c. All qualified applicants will have an equal opportunity to compete for the scholarship. There will be no restrictions as to race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.
 - d. Applicants may be asked to appear before the Selection Committee for a personal interview.
- 7. A minimum of two \$500 scholarships will be presented per year, with the number of scholarships and the amount varying with the available funds.
- 8. Recipients will be awarded certificates of scholarship award at their school honors day.

BOONE COUNTY 4-H CAT PROJECT SCHOLARSHIP



- 1. This scholarship is open to any high school senior at the time of application who has been an active member of Boone County 4-H cat project for the last 5 years of 4-H eligibility and is presently enrolled in Boone County 4-H.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded to the recipient regardless of the recipient's school choice. However, awards will be honored only if the recipient is enrolled in the selected school beginning with the semester immediately following graduation.
- 3. Money will be given for two semesters or terms; one-half August 1; one-half December 1 provided that at least a C average or deemed equivalent if maintained the first semester. The money will be mailed directly to the recipient.
- 4. If for any reason the recipient does not remain in school during the first semester the scholarship will be forfeited and he or she must immediately notify the 4-H. Youth Educator, Boone County Extension Office.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained from the Boone County Extension Office or local schools. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1st.
- 6. The 4-H Scholarship(s) will be awarded to the applicant(s) who, in the judgment of the Selection Committee, appear most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - a. The applicant shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school and community involvement will be considered.
 - b. The applicant's academic record and career goals will be considered.

This scholarship is open to any high school senior at the time of application who has been an active member of Boone County 4-H for the last five (5) years of 4-H eligibility and has completed three (3) years in the Boone County 4-H Horse and Pony program, and is presently enrolled in Boone County 4-H.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded regardless of the recipient's school choice; however, the recipient must be enrolled in the selected school.
- 3. The recipient must begin classes no later than the Fall term following graduation from high school. Seventh (7th) semester graduates are eligible to apply and must follow the above criteria.
- 4. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the recipient.
- 5. If for any reason the recipient does not remain in school, the scholarship will be forfeited.
- 6. Application forms may be obtained at the Boone County Extension Office. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1 of the current year.
- 7. The 4-H Horse and Pony Scholarship(s) will be awarded to the applicant(s) who in the judgment of the 4-H Selection Committee appears to be the most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - a. The recipient shall possess good leadership potential was well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school, and community involvement will be considered.
 - b. The recipient's academic record and career goals will be considered.
 - c. Financial need may be a factor but is not necessary to receive the award. It will be considered only in the instance of two (2) candidates of equal qualifications.
 - d. All qualified applicants will have an equal opportunity for consideration for the award. There will be no restrictions as to race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.
 - e. Applicants may be asked to appear before the Selection Committee for a personal interview.
- 8. A minimum of one (1) \$250 scholarship will be awarded per year, with the number of scholarships and the amount varying with the available funds.

BOONE COUNTY 4-H LLAMA PROJECT SCHOLARSHIP



- 1. This scholarship is open to any high school senior at the time of application who has been an <u>active</u> member of Boone County 4-H Llama/Alpaca project for at least 5 years of 4-H eligibility and is presently enrolled in Boone County 4-H.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded to the recipient regardless of the recipient's school choice. However, awards will be honored only if the recipient is enrolled in the selected school beginning with the semester immediately following graduation.
- 3. The recipient must begin classes no later than the Fall term following graduation from high school. Seventh (7th) semester graduates are eligible to apply and must follow the above criteria.
- 4. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the recipient. Money will be received at the beginning of the second semester or beyond. The recipient may be asked to present a copy of their grade transcript as proof they have completed their first semester and are enrolled in their second semester. This is a one-time only scholarship.
- 5. If for any reason the recipient does not remain in school during the first semester the scholarship will be forfeited and he or she must immediately notify the 4-H Youth Educator, Boone County Extension Office.
- 6. Application forms may be obtained from the Boone County Extension Office or local schools. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1st.
- 7. The 4-H Scholarship(s) will be awarded to the applicant(s) who, in the judgment of the Selection Committee, appear most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - a. The applicant shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school and community involvement will be considered.
 - b. The applicant's academic record and career goals will be considered.
 - c. Financial need may be a factor but is not necessary to receive the award. It will be considered only in the instance of two (2) candidates of equal qualifications.

BOONE COUNTY BEEF PRODUCERS SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. This scholarship is open to any 4-H'er who is a senior in high school at the time of application and who has been an active member of Boone County 4-H for at least five (5) years of 4-H eligibility and has completed five (5) years in Boone County 4-H Beef project. Applicants must presently be enrolled in the Boone County 4-H Beef project.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded regardless of the recipient's school choice; however, the recipient must be enrolled in selected school.
- 3. The recipient must begin classes no later than the fall term following graduation from high school. Seventh (7th) semester graduates are eligible to apply and must follow the above criteria.
- 4. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the recipient. Money will be received at the beginning of the second semester or upon enrollment if entering third semester.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained at the Boone County Extension Office. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1 of the current year.
- 6. The Boone County Beef Producers Scholarship will be awarded to the applicant(s) who in the judgment of the selection committee appears to be the most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - a. The recipient shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school, and community involvement will be considered.

BOONE COUNTY DAIRY PROMOTERS SCHOLARSHIP In Memory of Ed Darrough

- 1. The scholarship is open to any 4-H'er who is a senior in high school, is an active member of Boone County 4-H, has completed 3 years in the Dairy project, and is presently enrolled in the Boone County 4-H Dairy Project.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded regardless of the recipient's school choice. However, the recipient must be enrolled in selected school.
- 3. The recipient must begin classes no later than the fall term following graduation from high school. Seventh (7th) semester graduates are eligible to apply and must follow the above criteria.
- 4. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the recipient. Money will be received at the beginning of the second semester or beyond. The recipient may be asked to present a copy of their grade transcript as proof they have completed their first semester and are enrolled in their second semester.
- **5.** Application forms may be obtained at the Boone County Extension Office. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1 of the current year.
- 6. The Boone County Dairy Promoters Scholarship will be awarded to the applicant(s) who in the judgment of the Selection Committee appear to be the most deserving based on the following criteria:

 - b. Applicants must have worked at least one shift in the Boone County Dairy Promoters Fair Shake Stand (starting for 2017 graduates).
 - c. The recipient's academic record and career goals will be considered.
 - d. Financial need may be a factor but is not necessary to receive the award. It will be considered only in the instance of two (2) candidates of equal qualifications.
 - e. All qualified applicants will have an equal opportunity for consideration for the award. There will be no restrictions as to race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.
 - f. Applicants may be asked to appear before the Selection Committee for a personal interview.
- 7. A total of \$1,000 in scholarship money will be available per year, with the number of scholarships and the amount awarded varying with available funds.
- 8. Recipient(s) will be awarded the scholarship during the County 4-H Dairy Show.
- 9. Scholarship is not renewable. Recipients will be awarded one scholarship from the Boone County Dairy Promoters.

BOONE COUNTY PORK PRODUCERS SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. This scholarship is open to any 4-H'er who is a senior in high school at the time of application and has been an active member of Boone County 4-H for at least five (5) years of 4-H eligibility and has completed five (5) years in the Boone County 4-H Swine project.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded regardless of the recipient's school choice; however, the recipient must be enrolled in school.
- 3. The recipient must begin classes no later than the fall term following graduation from high school. Seventh (7th) semester graduates are eligible to apply and must follow the above criteria.
- 4. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the recipient. Money will be received at the beginning of the second semester or beyond.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained at the Boone County Extension Office. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1 of the current year.
- 6. The Boone County Pork Producers Scholarship will be awarded to the applicant(s) who in the judgment of the Selection Committee appear to be the most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - a. The recipient shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school, and community involvement will be considered.
 - b. The recipient's academic record and career goals will be considered.
 - c. Financial need may be a factor but is not necessary to receive the award. It will be considered only in the instance of two (2) candidates of equal qualifications.
 - d. All qualified applicants will have an equal opportunity for consideration for the award. There will be no restrictions as to race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.
 - e. Applicants may be asked to appear before the Selection Committee for a personal interview.
- 7. A total of \$3,000 in scholarship money will be available per year, with the number of scholarships and the amount awarded varying.
- 8. Recipient(s) will be awarded the scholarship during the County 4-H Swine Show.
- 9. Scholarship is not renewable. Recipients will be awarded one scholarship from the Boone County Pork Producers. 4-Her's who apply and are not awarded a scholarship may reapply each year that they are eligible.

Darrell A Portell 4-H Memorial Scholarship

- 1. This Scholarship is open to any high school senior at the time of application who has been an active member of the Boone County 4-H program for the last three (3) years of 4-H eligibility.
- Special consideration will be given to an applicant who has been active in 4-H Horse & Pony,
 Horsemen without Horses, Swine, Photography, Computers, Gift Wrapping, Cake Decorating,
 Junior Leaders or Shooting Sports projects for at least 2 years, or a junior member of the Fair
 Board or 4-H Council who has been an assistant to a Fair Board Member (assisting with the fair
 setup, barns, etc)
- 3. Scholarships will be awarded regardless of the recipient's school choice; however, the recipient must be enrolled in the selected Trade School, college or university for the fall semester.
- 4. If for any reason the recipient does not remain in school, the scholarship will be forfeited. Please mail fall & spring grades or registration to 4-H office as proof.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained at the Boone County Extension Office. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by **March 1st** of the current year.
- 6. The Scholarship(s) will be awarded to the applicant(s) who in the judgment of the
- 7. 4-H Selection Committee appear to be the most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - A. The recipient shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school, and community involvement will be considered.
 - B. The recipient's academic record and career goals will be considered.
 - C. Financial need may be a factor but is not necessary to receive the award. It will be considered only in the instance of two (2) candidates of equal qualifications.
 - D. All qualified applicants will have an equal opportunity for consideration for the award. There will be no restrictions as to race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.
 - E. Applicants may be asked to appear before the Selection Committee for a personal interview.
- 8. A minimum of one \$250 scholarship will be awarded per year.
- 9. Recipient(s) will be awarded the scholarship during the awards program at their school.

Bill Canada Memorial 4-H Scholarship

The Bill Canada Memorial 4-H Scholarship will be awarded annually. All Boone County 4-H members who are in their 10th year of 4-H at the time of application are eligible to apply. If the recipient does not complete their 10th year of 4-H, the award will be presented to the alternate. The recipient is to use this scholarship to advance their education beyond high school. One scholarship in the amount of \$300 will be awarded. A committee of 4-H members, one from each township, who have completed at least 5 years of 4-H will select the recipient based on the following criteria as it relates to the applicant's 4-H career:

- Helpfulness to others
- Character
- Citizenship
- Sportsmanship
- Knowledge gained from 4-H
- Community service

Completed applications are due in the Boone County Extension Office March 1st of the year the applicant is completing their 10th year of Boone County 4-H membership.

Mark Cunningham Memorial Scholarship

4 year college

- 1. This scholarship is open to any 4-H'er who is a senior in high school at the time of application and who has been an active member of Boone County 4-H for at least five (5) years of 4-H eligibility and has completed five (5) years in Boone County 4-H Beef project. Applicants must presently be enrolled in the Boone County 4-H Beef project.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded to a recipient going to a 4 year college of their choices; however, the recipient must be enrolled in selected school.
- 3. The recipient must begin classes no later than the fall term following graduation from high school. Seventh (7th) semester graduates are eligible to apply and must follow the above criteria.
- 4. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the recipient. Money will be received at the beginning of the second semester or upon enrollment if entering third semester.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained at the Boone County Extension Office. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1 of the current year.
- 6. The Mark Cunningham Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to the applicant(s) who in the judgment of the selection committee appears to be the most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - a. The recipient shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school, and community involvement will be considered.
 - b. The recipient's academic record and career goals will be considered.
 - c. Financial need may be a factor but is not necessary to receive the award. It will be considered only in the instance of two (2) candidates of equal qualifications.
 - d. All qualified applicants will have an equal opportunity for consideration for the award. There will be no restrictions as to race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.
 - e. Applicants may be asked to appear before the selection committee for a personal interview.
- 7. One (1) scholarship for a minimum of \$250 will be awarded per year, with the amount varying with the available funds.
- 8. Recipient(s) will be awarded the scholarship during the 4-H Beef Show at the Boone County Fair.
- 9. This scholarship is not renewable. 4-Her's who apply and are not awarded a scholarship may reapply each year that they are eligible.

Mark Cunningham Memorial Scholarship

2 year Jr. College/Continuing Education

- 1. This scholarship is open to any youth or young adult that falls into the following categories:
 - a. Any current 4-H member who is a senior in high school who has enrolled at a two (2) year Junior College and will be pursuing an agricultural degree. Applicants must be an active member of Boone County 4-H for at least five (5) years of 4-H eligibility and must presently be enrolled in the Boone County 4-H Beef project
 - b. Any past Boone County 4-H member who is a current student at a two (2) year Junior College or four (4) year college majoring in agriculture who would like to take a continuing education course. Applicants must have completed at least (5) years of 4-H in Boone County and must have been in the 4-H beef project his/her senior year of high school.
- 2. Scholarships will be awarded to a recipient going to a two (2) year Jr. College majoring in an agriculture related field or enrolled in a continuing education class based on agriculture of their choices; however, the recipient must be enrolled in selected school or show proof in enrollment of the continuing education class before money will be distributed.
- 3. If the recipient is using the scholarship to attend a two (2) year Jr. College the recipient must begin classes no later than the fall term following graduation from high school. Seventh (7th) semester graduates are eligible to apply and must follow the above criteria. If the recipient is using the scholarship to attend a continuing educator course, the course must be taken between August 1 of the current year and July 31st of next year.
- 4. The scholarship money will be mailed directly to the recipient. If the recipient is using the scholarship to attend a two (2) year Jr. College, the money will be received at the beginning of the second semester or upon enrollment if entering third semester. If the scholarship is being used for a continuing educator course, money will be received after proof of enrollment in class is shown. Proof of enrollment should be sent to the 4-H Youth Development Extension Educator.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained at the Boone County Extension Office. Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by March 1 of the current year.
- 6. The Mark Cunningham Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to the applicant(s) who in the judgment of the selection committee appears to be the most deserving based on the following criteria:
 - a. The recipient shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school, and community involvement will be considered.
 - b. The recipient's academic record and career goals will be considered.
 - c. Financial need may be a factor but is not necessary to receive the award. It will be considered only in the instance of two (2) candidates of equal qualifications.

- d. All qualified applicants will have an equal opportunity for consideration for the award. There will be no restrictions as to race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.
- e. Applicants may be asked to appear before the selection committee for a personal interview.
- 7. One (1) scholarship for a minimum of \$250 will be awarded per year, with the amount varying depending on the available funds.
- 8. Recipient(s) will be awarded the scholarship during the 4-H Beef Show at the Boone County Fair.
- 9. This scholarship is renewable, but first consideration will go to applicant that has not received the scholarship before. Applicants who apply and are not awarded a scholarship may reapply each year that they are eligible.
