### Graduation Requirements—CORE 40

- English: 8 credits
- Math: 6 credits (Alg 1, Alg 2, Geom)
  - Must earn 6 Math credits **during HS**
  - Must also be enrolled in Math or Quantitative Reasoning **every year**
- Science: 6 credits (Bio, ICP/Chem/Physics)
- Social Studies: 6 credits (Geog/World, US Hist, Govt, Econ)
- PE: 2 credits
- Health: 1 credit (or FACS sequence)
- Preparing for College and Careers: 1 credit
- Total: 42
- STUDENTS MUST ALSO PASS A GRADUATION QUALIFYING EXAM (ISTEP 10) IN ENGLISH AND MATH

## Graduation Requirements—Academic Honors Diploma

- English: 8 credits
- Math: 8 credits (Alg 1, Alg 2, Geom)
  - Must earn 6 Math credits **during HS**
  - Must also be **enrolled** in Math or Quantitative Reasoning every year
- Science: 6 credits (Bio, ICP/Chem/Physics)
- Social Studies: 6 credits (Geog/World, US Hist, Govt, Econ)
- PE: 2 credits
- Health: 1 credit (or FACS sequence)
- Fine Arts: 2 credits
- World Language: 6 credits in one language
- Preparing for College and Careers: 1 credit
- Total: 47

## Additional Requirements Academic Honors Diploma

- C- or higher in courses that count toward diploma
- Overall GPA 3.0 or higher
- Complete 1 of the following:
  - Complete AP courses (4 credits) and exams
  - Complete Dual Credit courses from “Priority Course List” (6 transcribed college credits)
  - Complete 1 AP course (2 credits) with exam AND Dual Credit course(s) from “Priority Course List” (3 transcribed college credits)
  - SAT Score 1250 or higher (with minimum 560 on math and 590 on evidence based reading and writing)
  - ACT composite 26 or higher (must include writing)

## Graduation Requirements—Technical Honors Diploma

- English: 8 credits
- Math: 6 credits (Alg 1, Alg 2, Geom)
  - Must earn 6 Math credits **during HS**
  - Must also be **enrolled** in Math or Quantitative Reasoning every year
- Science: 6 credits (Bio, ICP/Chem/Physics)
- Social Studies: 6 credits (Geog/World, US Hist, Govt, Econ)
- PE: 2 credits
- Health: 1 credit (or FACS sequence)
- College & Career Pathway: 6 credits
- Preparing for College and Careers: 1 credit
- Total: 47

## Additional Requirements Technical Honors Diploma

- C- or higher in courses that count toward diploma
- Overall GPA 3.0 or higher
- Complete 1 of the following:
  - “Pathway designated” industry-based certification
  - “Pathway designated” dual credits (6 transcribed college credits from “priority course list”)
- Complete 1 of the following:
  - WorkKeys (minimum scores TBA)
  - Accuplacer minimum scores (Writing: 80; Reading: 90; Math: 75)
  - Compass minimum scores (Algebra: 66; Writing: 70; Reading: 80)
  - Complete AP courses (4 credits) and exams
  - Complete Dual Credit courses from “Priority Course List” (6 transcribed college credits)
  - Complete 1 AP course (2 credits) with exam AND Dual Credit course(s) from “Priority Course List” (3 transcribed college credits)
  - SAT Score 1250 or higher (with minimum 560 on math and 590 on evidence based reading and writing)
  - ACT composite 26 or higher must include writing

## AP/Dual Credit

- Advanced Placement (AP)
  - Earn HS credit
  - AP Exam score CAN qualify you for college credit
    - Currently IN pays for math, science, English, and free/reduced
    - \$94 exam fee for all others
  - English Lit, English Lang, Biology, World History, US History, Microeconomics, Studio Art
- Dual Credit
  - Earn HS and College credit (university transcript)
  - Vincennes
    - Radio/TV (free)
  - Ivy Tech (free)
    - Calculus, PreCalc/Trig, Anatomy/Physiology, Spanish 3H & 4, Intro to Eng. Design, Principles of Engineering, Digital Electronics, Intro to Manufacturing, most Ag, some Vocational

## CTE (Vocational) Options

- Available Junior and/or Senior Year
- Off-site 3-4 periods
- Must provide own transportation
- Must be on track with graduation requirements

## Other Considerations

- Consider your major/career path
- NCAA/NAIA Requirements
- Requirements vary from college to college
  - Some common admission requirements for all majors include:
    - Minimum 2 years world language
    - 4<sup>th</sup> year of math (Trig/PreCalc)

## WEBO Elective Options Entering Grade 9 (Class of 2022)

- World Language    3 years Required for Acad. Honors Diploma
- Fine Arts            1 year Required for Acad. Honors Diploma
- Begin Career Pathway in Ag, FACS, PLTW, etc.
