- The applicant should be involved in providing some form of community service that is identified in their application.

- The \$1,250.00 award will be provided to the winning recipient at one of the Crawfordsville Kiwanis' regular meetings.
- The award will be made payable to the recipient for their use in pursuing their trade or further training.
